



2010 ADULT BASEBALL PLAY-OFF PROCEDURES

- I. If the same team wins all rounds, they are league champions.
- II. In leagues with two rounds, if there are two different round winners, the winner of Round I will play the winner of Round II for the league championship. (even with unbalanced Pacific League for 2010).
- III. If there are ties within a round, the following tie breaking procedure will determine round winners:
 - a. If only two teams are tied, head to head competition will determine the round winner. If head to head competition cannot determine champion a playoff will take place.
 - b. If three teams or more are tied a drawing for byes or opponents will occur, games will be played as part of double headers where possible, and the winner takes the round.
- IV. A coin toss will determine home team for all play-off games. If a single league championship game is scheduled at a diamond, the time limit will be 2 hours 15 minutes or 7 innings. All other rules will apply during play-offs.
