



Adult Basketball Leagues Frequently Asked Questions

When are registration materials available and where can I obtain them?

Registration material for MSCR Winter Basketball leagues is available:

October 12 – November 6 (Teams that played in the 2009 winter basketball program will have a packet mailed to their manager).

When does team registration take place?

Registration for the MSCR Winter Basketball Program will be held:

Tues., November 10 from 8am – 6pm., Wed., November 11 from 8am – 4pm, and Thurs., November 12 from 8am – 4pm at the MSCR Office, 3802 Regent St. Anyone can register the team. At the time of registration, teams must have 7 signed player contracts and all fees are due (no exceptions). **All** teams registering during the 3-day registration period will be accepted into the program.

I am new to the area and would like to join a team. Do you know of teams that are in need of players?

Teams in the MSCR program are formed by individuals, not by MSCR. However, we compile a “player pool” of players looking to join a team and make the list available to managers who are looking to add players to their team. If you would like to be placed on this pool, simply go on-line to our website at www.mscr.org and fill out and submit the Player Referral Form, from the Adult Sports League menu. Your name will be added to the pool. There is no fee involved until you join a team. MSCR can not guarantee that you will be placed on a team. If you would like to organize a team of your own, consider using the Player Referral Pool to identify interested players!

Question: What are the fees involved to register a team?

Question: Who are the leagues for?

Leagues are for men and women ages 18 and older who are Madison Metropolitan School District residents. You must have a minimum of 7 players to register. 50% of your roster may be nonresidents of the Madison Metropolitan School District. Not sure if you are part of the school district? Question: When will schedules be available for teams?

Winter Basketball schedules will be mailed out to all team managers the week of December 14, 2009 and will also be posted at www.msqr.org.

Question: Can I play on more than one team?

People may play on multiple teams as long as they only play on one team per night. They must have a player contract signed for each team they play on. They cannot sub on Team A, even for one game, without a contract for Team A, even though they have a contract for Team B.

Question: Where are games played?**WINTER BASKETBALL SITES:**

1	ALLIS -	4201 Buckeye Rd., off Jerome St. Go through gate at end of lot. Enter double doors to the gym.
2	CHEROKEE -	4301 Cherokee Dr. Lot behind school. Enter doors from rear lot, go down the steps; gym is to the right.
3	EAST HIGH & FIELDHOUSE -	2222 E. Washington Ave. Park in large lot off 4 th St. To enter school, go up the steps between fieldhouse & school. Enter door #4 and go up steps on your left; Gym B & G are on the right. For the fieldhouse, follow hallway 'til it ends, turn left and entrance is ahead.
4	HAMILTON (Van Hise) -	Enter off Segoe Rd. between Marathon Dr. and Richard Ln. to rear lot on east side of school. Use double glass doors. Gym is on the left.
5	LA FOLLETTE HIGH & FIELDHOUSE -	702 Pflaum Rd. Gym B & G: enter door #4 east (follow sidewalk to right). Go down hall, turn right; gym is on left. Fieldhouse #1 – 4: Park in north end of large lot near the practice fields & tennis courts. Enter door #5 north. Gyms are down the hallway to the right.
6	MEMORIAL HIGH FIELDHOUSE -	201 S. Gammon Rd. Lot off Gammon Rd. between Memorial & Jefferson schools. Enter glass doors. Go halfway down the hall. Turn left. Courts #1 – 4 are on the left.
7	MIDVALE -	502 Caromar Dr. Park on street or in lot at south end of school. Enter doors on Caromar, near flag pole. go down the steps; gym is on the right.
8	SHERMAN -	1601 N. Sherman Ave. Lot off Ruskin St. Enter doors next to the lot, go down hall; gym is to the left.
9	TOKI (Or. Ridge) -	5606 Russett Rd. Lot off Whitney Way. Use 4 door entry closest to playfield, take hallway to the right; gym is on the left.
10	WEST HIGH -	30 Ash St. Park on Regent St. and side streets. Enter glass doors(3a or 3b) on Regent St. nearest Speedway Rd. Gym 261: right, Gym 263: center, Gym 265: left.
